EMMET COUNTY AGRICULTURAL SHOW BOARD MEMBER POSITION DESCRIPTION

Purpose: The Emmet County Agricultural Show Board member is responsible for working with the full board to organize, plan and conduct an annual county fair, executing additional activities consistent with this objective for the Emmet County community and surrounding area.

Essential Functions:

- Attend monthly board meetings, occasional functions and special events
- Serve on a committee in special capacities commensurate with skills
- Be available for assigned tasks and frequent shifts for the days leading up to and week of the fair reoccurring in July
- Remain informed about the organization's mission, services, policies and programs and keep up-to-date on developments of the board
- Have a spirit of humor and fun

Qualifications: The Board should have a mix of membership from public, private and nonprofit sectors who bring a variety of professional skills and a willingness to donate personal time and energy to further the mission of the Emmet County Agricultural Show, and Board members should not have business or personal involvement of interest or are otherwise incompatible with board service.

Time Commitment: Board members are elected for a term of three (3) years, with no limits to the number of consecutive terms. The Board of Directors meets once per month for approximately two hours.

Duties of the Fair Board Members: To ensure a successful fair, board members are responsible for the yearly occurrence and day-to-day operations of the Emmet County Fair and need to help:
