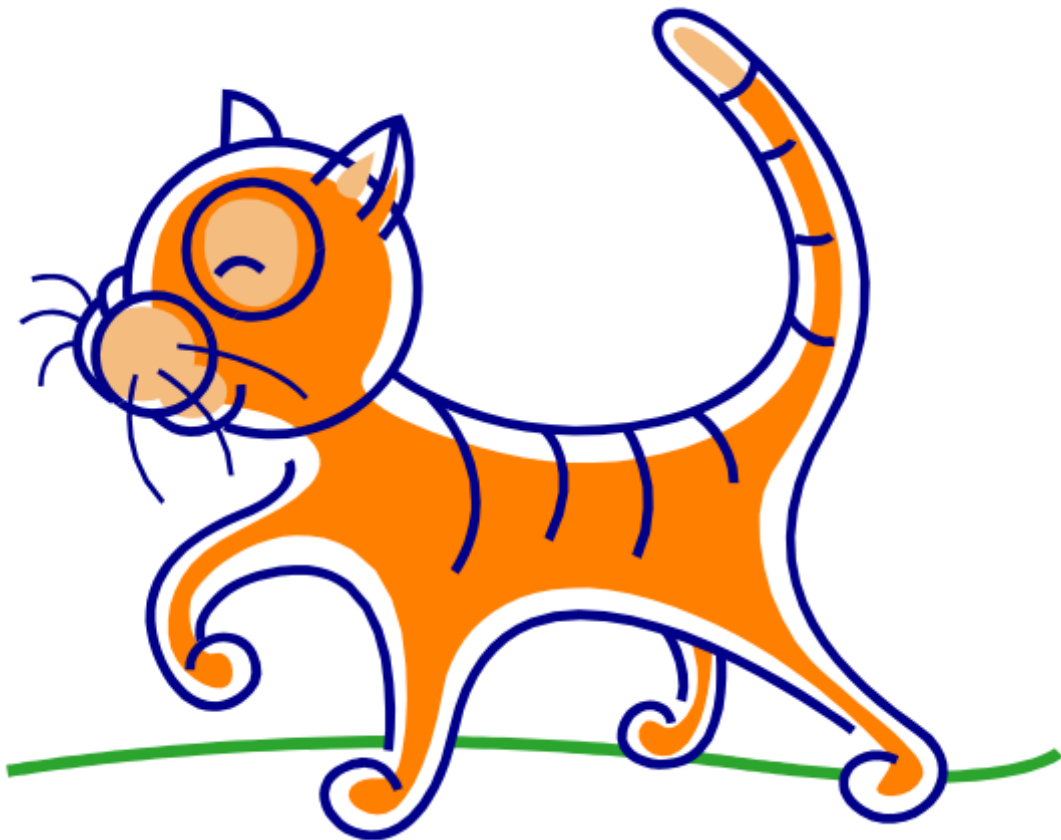

Introduction

Any Emmet County youth completing Kindergarten through 3rd (pre 4-H) by fair, enrolled in the Open Class Pet Project can exhibit in this class.

Objectives

1. To learn proper health care and nutritional requirements of their pet.
2. To learn basic grooming skills.
3. To learn basic record keeping skills.

Guidelines

1. Open to youth that have completed Kindergarten through third grade at the time of the show.
2. Pets need to have up-to-date proof of appropriate vaccinations due with entry form.
3. A photo of pet and the youth must be included on the ID sheet.
4. Any bottle calf(s) or bottle lamb(s) cannot be used as a pet.
5. Entry form is due by July 1.

Pets at the County Fair

1. Pets will be show on a proper leash or cage at the Emmet County Fair.
2. Pets will arrive the day of the show and leave following the show.
