
YOUR EMMET COUNTY OPEN CLASS PET PROJECT



Introduction

Objectives

- 1. To learn proper health care and nutritional requirements of their pet.
- 2. To learn basic grooming skills.
- 3. To learn basic record keeping skills.

Guidelines

- 1. Open to youth that have completed Kindergarten through third grade at the time of the show.
- 2. Pets need to have up-to-date proof of appropriate vaccinations due with entry form.
- 3. A photo of pet and the youth must be included on the ID sheet.
- 4. Any bottle calf(s) or bottle lamb(s) cannot be used as a pet.
- 5. Entry form is due by July 1.

- 2. Pets will arrive the day of the show and leave following the show.
